



## HIGH-EFFICIENCY CLOTHES WASHER REBATES AVAILABLE

January 1 – December 31, 2016

PG&E and the City of Calistoga are working together to offer a streamlined rebate process to customers who purchase high-efficiency clothes washers.

Earn a combined rebate for your purchase of a qualified water and energy-efficient clothes washer and save energy, water, and money for the life of your new appliance.

Rebate amounts are based on clothes washers labeled as Energy Star Most Efficient (ESME) 2016. For more information about the current ESME list of eligible residential clothes washers, please visit [www.waterenergysavings.com](http://www.waterenergysavings.com). ESME models qualify for a maximum rebate of \$150 per unit, apportioned at \$50 paid by PG&E and \$100 paid by the City of Calistoga.

### HOW TO PARTICIPATE

1. You must be a customer of both the City of Calistoga Water Department and PG&E with active water and electric meters.
2. Purchase a new, eligible high-efficiency clothes washer, installed at a site served by the City of Calistoga Water Department and PG&E.
3. Complete an application and submit it with all required documentation to the address on the form or apply online at [www.waterenergysavings.com](http://www.waterenergysavings.com). Applications may be downloaded from the above-mentioned website or picked up at Calistoga City Hall – 1232 Washington Street.
4. All rebate applications must be postmarked, or received online, no later than 90 days after purchase date, and no later than March 31, 2017.
5. Sales receipt must include purchaser name, installation address, purchase date, installation date, purchase price, and clothes washer brand and model number.

***Clothes washers purchased before January 1, 2016 do not qualify for this program.  
However, if a qualifying clothes washer was purchased in 2015, you have until March 31, 2016  
to make an application.***
