For Children Ages 6 months– 2 years



Shrimp and Lobster

Parents and children will explore the pool together, sign songs, engage in beginning swimming skills and water safety. **Parent Participation required.**

For Children Ages 6-12



Seahorse

Beginning swimmers who are unsure of the water. Basic skills such as blowing bubbles and floating with support are introduced.

For Children Ages 3-5



Starfish

Introductory skills are taught using water play. Participants will learn skills such as blowing bubbles and putting their face in the water.



Turtle

For beginning swimmers who like water. Basic skills such as submerging their head, floating, and basic stroke work will be taught. Prerequisite: Completion of Otter or Seahorse



Guppy

For swimmers still learning about water. Participants will work on back/front float and introductory kicking. Prerequisite: Completion of Starfish



Seal

Swimmers who are comfortable in the water and know basic strokes. Work on front and back crawl. Prerequisite: Completion of Sea Turtle.



Otter

This class is for swimmers who are comfortable in water. Arm strokes and combining skills will be worked on in this class. Prerequisite: Completion of Guppy



Ray

Swimmers will work on endurance during front and back crawl and an introduction to side breathing and breast stroke. Prerequisite: Completion of Seal

Swordfish



Swimmers will work on stroke refinement, endurance, and front crawl using side breathing. Prerequisite: Completion of Ray


Private Lessons
