The home occupation permit shall be valid only for the person to whom it is issued, at the address at which it is issued, and during the period of time for which a valid, unexpired City business license is in effect. Failure to properly renew said license or failure to comply with any of the conditions of approval will render the permit null and void.

Prohibited Home Occupation Uses:

- Automotive and other vehicle repair, including mobile repair services (body or mechanical), upholstery, painting, or storage;
- Carpentry or cabinet making;
- Welding and machine operations;
- Medical offices, clinics or laboratories;
- Animal hospitals and grooming facilities;
- Contractor's storage yards or junk yards;
- Escort services;
- Dancing, martial arts or exercise studios which serve more than two persons during any four hour period;
- Day care for greater than seven (7) children;
- Dealing in or with firearms.
- Other uses similar in nature to the foregoing which are determined to be incompatible with or detrimental to residential activities by the Director of Planning and Building.
