ISSUE:

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Consideration of a Resolution awarding a contract in the amount of \$17,335 to Wilson Construction for crosswalk Improvements and intersection realignment at Washington Street and North Oak Street and Authorizing the Public Works Director to Install the Traffic Improvements.

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RECOMMENDATION:

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Adopt the Resolution.

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BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

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The City of Calistoga received a Transportation Development Act, Article 3 (TDA-3) Grant from the Metropolitan Transportation Commission for bike and pedestrian improvements. One of the projects that were approved consists of crosswalk improvements and intersection re-alignment to a 3-way stop at the intersection of Washington Street and North Oak Street. These improvements will make it safer for pedestrians to cross the street to the Logvy Community Park and Pool.

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The intersection realignment will also allow for a future crosswalk across North Oak Street, when a sidewalk is eventually placed on the West side of North Oak Street.

24 All current and planned improvements at this intersection are consistent with the 25

Logvy Park Master Plan, approved by City Council on October 6, 2009. Although

the 3-way stop intersection realignment and the crosswalk are part of the approved

Logvy Park Master Plan, specific authority from Council is requested here to install

the noted traffic improvements.

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Staff requested and received the following bids for the project:

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1.	Wilson Construction -	St. Helena	\$17,335
2.	Helmer & Sons, Inc	Angwin	\$24,600
3.	Harold Smith & Son, Inc	St. Helena	\$25,585
4.	Blakeley Construction, Inc	Calistoga	\$27,531
5.	Wheeler Construction -	Windsor	\$28,749

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Staff has reviewed the bids and has determined that the bid from Wilson Construction is responsive and responsible. Staff recommends that a contract be awarded to Wilson Construction in the amount of \$17,335.

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FISCAL IMPACT:

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Funds are budgeted for this project in FY 2010/11 Streets Capital Account #01-5510. Expenditures will be reimbursed through the TDA-3 grant from Metropolitan Transportation Commission.

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALISTOGA, COUNTY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA,

AUTHORIZING AWARDING A CONTRACT TO WILSON CONTRUCTION
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$17,335 FOR CROSSWALK AND INTERSECTION
REALIGNMENT IMPROVEMENTS AT THE INTERSECTION OF
WASHINGTON STREET AND NORTH OAK STREET, AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS
DIRECTOR TO INSTALL THE TRAFFIC IMPROVEMENTS
AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT

WHEREAS, a three-way stop intersection and crosswalks are planned at the intersection of Washington Street and North Oak Street on the Logvy Park Master Plan, approved by Council on October 6, 2009; and

WHEREAS, proposals were received for the Crosswalk Improvements / Intersection Re-alignment Project on February 28, 2011 in accordance with Calistoga Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, five proposals were received by the City, with the low proposer being Wilson Construction in the amount of \$17,335; and

WHEREAS, project funds in the form of a grant from the Metropolitan Transportation Commission were budgeted in the 2010/11 Capital Improvement Project Budget (Account 01-5510); and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Calistoga hereby resolves as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as findings of the City Council of the City of Calistoga.
- 2. In accordance with the Calistoga Municipal Code 10.12.010, the City Council of the City of Calistoga hereby authorizes a 3-way stop intersection and crosswalks at the intersection of Washington Street and North Oak Street.
- 3. In accordance with the Calistoga Municipal Code and other applicable law, the City Council of the City of Calistoga hereby finds the proposal of Wilson Construction, for the Crosswalk Improvements / Intersection Realignment Project to be the lowest, responsive proposal.
- 4. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract with Wilson Construction in an amount not to exceed \$17,335, for performance of the Project in accordance with the proposal documents and applicable law upon submission by Wilson Construction of all documents required pursuant to the Project solicitation documents, contingent upon approval by the City Attorney.
