**ISSUE:** To consider a Resolution authorizing the use of Washington Street from First Street to Second Street for the Calistoga Chamber of Commerce "Calistoga's Big 125<sup>th</sup>

- 3 Street to Second Street for the Calisto4 Birthday Celebration" on July 16, 2011.
- 5 **RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt Resolution
- BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: Any event which requires closure of a Calistoga city street, City Council approval is required. Furthermore each applicant must provide required insurance and comply with any terms or conditions applied to the permit.
- The Calistoga Chamber of Commerce has applied for a Special Event Permit for their "Calistoga's Big 125<sup>th</sup> Birthday Party". The celebration is planned for July 16, 2011 from
- 12:00 PM to 5:00 PM. The event will include live music and entertainment on a portable
- stage which will be located on Washington Street.
- 13 The event planners are requesting the closure of Washington Street from First to
- 14 Second Streets. There are approximately 500 visitors expected and approximately 20
- 15 volunteers at the event.
- 16 This closure will not impact any private resident parking but will close the public parking
- 17 lots at the Community Center and Police Department. Furthermore, it will impact the
- 18 Farmers Market activities. There will be a one emergency lane on Washington Street
- 19 from First Street to Second Street..
- 20 If the Council authorizes these uses of public streets, staff will process the specific
- 21 Special Event Permit and establish conditions of approval.
- 22 **FISCAL IMPACT**: The use of public streets for special events has no significant fiscal
- 23 impact on the City. The potential positive impact on local businesses and merchants
- 24 depends on the success the event has in drawing visitors to the community.
