Re: Revisions to Bike Map

Dear Erik:

I am writing on behalf of the members of the Calistoga Bicycle Advisory Committee to transmit the recommendations of the group for revisions to Calistoga's bike network map. These changes were discussed at the BAC meeting at City Hall on August 10, 2011

The group recommends that Petrified Forest road be designated as a future Class III bike path because of the presence of the newly built Highland Christian Church with its school. When the needed improvements are made to the road, parents and children will be able to bike to the facility safely. Additionally, a Class III bike path will improve the safety of cyclists using Petrified Forest Road when entering or exiting the popular 'Franz Valley Loop.' One final benefit is that a Class III bike path will enhance bicycle route connectivity between Napa and Sonoma counties.


The group also recommends that the Fair Way extension on the map meet the current Washington Street Bike Path with an alignment behind the Tedeschi Field. This will eliminate the segment of the down-valley segment of Fair Way that parallels the existing Class I bike path.
