ISSUE: To consider a Resolution authorizing the use of Washington Street from First

to Second Streets for the Calistoga Chamber of Commerce Blues Fest on October 22,

4 2011.

5 **RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt Resolution

6 BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: Any event which requires closure of a Calistoga city

7 street requires City Council approval. Furthermore each applicant must provide required

8 insurance and comply with any terms or conditions applied to the permit.

- 9 The Calistoga Chamber of Commerce has applied for a Special Event Permit for their
- Blues Fest. The celebration is planned for October 22, 2011 from 12:00 PM to 5:00 PM.
- 11 The event will include live music and entertainment on a portable stage which will be
- 12 located on Washington Street.
- 13 The event planners are requesting the closure of Washington Street from First to
- 14 Second Streets. There are approximately 1000 visitors expected and approximately 20
- 15 volunteers at the event.
- 16 This closure will not impact any private resident parking but will close the public parking
- 17 lots at the Community Center and Police Department. Furthermore, it will impact the
- 18 Farmers Market activities. There will be a one emergency lane access on Washington
- 19 Street from First to Second Streets.
- 20 If the Council authorizes these uses of public streets, staff will process the specific
- 21 Special Event Permit and establish conditions of approval.
- 22 **FISCAL IMPACT**: The use of public streets for special events has no significant fiscal
- 23 impact on the City. The potential positive impact on local businesses and merchants
- 24 depends on the success the event has in drawing visitors to the community.

WHEREAS, the closure of a city street requires city council approval, and;


WHEREAS, the Calistoga Chamber of Commerce has requested the use of a portion of Washington Street from First to Second Streets for their event, and:
