23 24 25 26 27	WHEREAS, funds for the Sidewalk Trip Hazard Inspection and Removal Project are budgeted at \$60,000 in Fiscal Year 2011-12 part of which is an \$8,000 grant from the City's insurance provider, PARSAC; and
28 29	<b>WHEREAS,</b> Staff recommends that the Program for Inspection and Repair of Sidewalk Trip Hazards be approved to begin in FY 11/12.
