A verbal and power point presentation was conducted by Eden Umble. Eden described how the Chamber has provided an on line Events Calendar and Resource Guide with information for visitors to Calistoga and a Community Calendar for smaller events of more interest to local citizens. Launch of the new web site for both calendars is set for May 1, 2008. Eventually there will also be a Food and Wine Calendar. The new web sites address is calistogavisitors.com. the process for all submissions to either calendar is:

- Information is submitted by an organization (City, school, club, promoter. etc...)
- Event information is done on the web site by completing the online form for upcoming events.
- All submissions are reviewed by Chamber to make sure they are legitimate and appropriate.
- After review Chamber places the event on one or both of the calendars.
- All submissions should be given to the Chamber at least 6 weeks prior to the planned event.

The Chamber's Resource List has the same information submission procedure as the Community Calendar and Events Calendar. The Resource List will have schools. churches, clubs, none profit organizations, etc...

- 2) Public Hearing Sidewalk Dining Ordinance, report by Planning Department. The presentation was made by Planning Director Charlene Gallina with assistance from Eric Lundquist. Ms. Gallina gave a reading of the proposed Sidewalk Dining Ordinance to the Community Resources Commission. The following components are part of the proposed ordinance.
 - First it is noted that Lincoln Ave and parts of Foothill Ave are under Caltrans jurisdiction.
 - Outdoor Dining will require a Conditional Use Permit from the Planning Commission.
 - Requires applicant to submit a description of proposed dining furniture and the type of eating and drinking utensils are to be used.
 - Public notice will be mailed to all properties within a 300 foot radius in order to solicit public comment on the new proposed use.
 - If approved applicant will be subject to annual review.
 - Space considerations must be made for people with disabilities, for fire hydrants, trees, traffic signs, opening car doors.

Commission comments and suggestions for the proposed Sidewalk Dining Ordinance:

- Commissioner Chang said "We want to encourage people to offer Sidewalk Dining, not to discourage restaurants.
- Chairperson More said "We first proposed this to enhance ambiance of downtown. The proposed process might become prohibitive with large fees. We don't want that for two or three tables."

There were several specific changes the Commissioners suggested.

Use permit fee should not be set at a prohibitive cost.

- Remove #13 No items may be placed in existing planted areas; from list of conditions.
- Remove #16 <u>Plastic furniture shall be discouraged</u> and replace with a different description for type of furniture.

Charlene Gallina final comments to the Commission was that the fees that are proposed to be charged are to pay for staff time and fee will probably be about \$50 annually. She thanked the Commission and said that the Commissioners suggestions would be presented to the Planning Commission for review.

- 3) Teen Open Forum and Friday Night Open Mike, presentation by Mary Cahill. Ms. Cahill gave a description of the event and brought up the ideas that the Teens had for new activities:
 - Monthly or bi-monthly Friday Open Mike Events at different locations.
 Possible other locations included Calistoga Roastery and Pioneer Park.
 Another suggestion was do several activities with the Friday, Open Mike Night. Those activities included food (cooking), craft contests, movies (Grease and maybe decorate a car/kids dress in a 50's style) and some comfortable seating.
 - Organization of a group of local teens to help/participate in the renovation project on Oat Hill Mine Road.
 - Cooking Classes for Teens
 - Skateboard Trip to a major skateboard park
 - Rafting trip either to the Sacramento Area or the Russian River area.
 - An overnight hiking trip on a local trail.
 - Swim Team, Water Polo
 - Junior High Dances
 - Ski Trips

- Astronomy possibly at PUC or with the help of Marvin Braun
- Sewing Class
- Dance (hip-hop)
- Field trips to Giant games, 6 Flags or to Water Park

Ms. Cahill said the Community Resources Department is in the process of planning to add some of these suggestions into this summer's Community Resources Department programming.

- 4) Fiscal Year 07-08 Work Program Update presentation by Mary Cahill. Ms. Cahill presented the existing 2007-2008 approved CRC Work Program and the Commissioners discussed the status of these goals and whether they had been completed:
- Pioneer Park rehabilitation. CRC made a recommendation that the gazebo be replaced with a roofed stage, picnic tables be moved, BBQ pit relocated, additional walkway added. This recommendation was forwarded to Department of Public Works which has moved picnic tables and added an additional

- walkway. Replacement of the Gazebo with a stage is still pending. No further action required by CRC. CRC has completed assignment.
 - Logvy house and immediate surrounding area improvements. The CRC has a representative on the Monhoff/Logvy Master plan Committee and gets updated on progress. No further action required by CRC. <u>CRC has completed</u> <u>assignment.</u>
 - Evaluations/Recommendations concerning all City Parks. The CRC has made recommendations concerning addition of a bike trail connecting all the parks, site recommendation for VFW Memorial at Logvy Park, discussion of community pool and is updated regularly of any new plans for our City parks. No further action required by CRC. <u>CRC has completed assignment.</u>
 - River walk and bike trails alongside Napa River. CRC has received presentation Bicycle Commission and made recommendation that concerned trails connecting all the City Parks. No further action required by CRC. <u>CRC has completed</u> <u>assignment.</u>
 - Downtown beautification. To be discussed.

- Street trees (tree committee). To be discussed. <u>CRC has completed</u> assignment.
- Outdoor dining (follow-up)- CRC has made recommendation and sent to Planning Department. CRC to receive presentation from Planning Department at 4/16/08 CRC meeting on status of ordinance. <u>CRC has completed assignment.</u> Commission would like to receive final Sidewalk Dining Ordinance.
- Youth Teen Issues CRC to receive report on Teen Forum and Open Mike Night at 4/16/08 CRC meeting. <u>Commission would like to leave this goal on 2008-2009 CRC Work Program.</u>
- Urban design plan (prioritize and advise). Planning Department is leading Urban Design process. CRC has completed assignment.
- Napa Co. Regional Parks and Open Space (opportunities) a local project that is currently being discussed by the County at Oat Hill Mine Road
- Community swimming pool (advise on programming, procedures, etc.).
 Commission would like to leave this goal on 2008-2009 CRC Work Program.
- Recreation Department program review (quarterly)
- Monhoff Center transformation to an Art Center, Planning for a new Teen Center at Logvy Community Park (facility and programming). Other uses for Logvy Community Park (facility planning). <u>Commission will hear regular reports on</u> <u>Oversight Committee's progress.</u>
- Hispanic (Change to <u>Latino</u>) Issues (<u>gang education remove</u>, employment education, Latino parents committee). <u>Commission would like to discuss housing and housing conditions.</u>
- Senior Issues (senior center, senior recreation programs, driving classes, computer accessibility). <u>Commission would like to leave this goal on 2008-2009 CRC Work Program.</u>
- Safety issues (sidewalks, electric cart registration and safety check, safety awareness programs, swimming pool safety issues). <u>CRC would like to remove</u> this from 2008-2009 CRC Work Program.
- Animal Control Issues Dog Park (funding, location, rules, amenities, etc...).
 CRC sent recommendation to Planning Department and should receive status report on progress at 4/16/08 CRC meeting. While Commission has sent a

recommendation to the Planning Commission it would like to follow this item to it's completion. 5) Discussion of possible Fiscal Year 08-09 CRC Goals. The discussion for this Item #5 took place during the discussion of Item #4. F) COMMISSIONER OPEN DISCUSSION Ms. Cahill said that Commissioners More, Chang and Harper were reappointed to the Community Resources Commission by the Mayor and City Council. She also said that Christopher Henderson had submitted an application for CRC appointment.
