He requested that all evidence be used in defense of the pending lawsuit. 60 61 Drew Sparks, 2412 Foothill Blvd, stated that she is holding the City Council to 62 their previous promise to uphold the City's Rent Stabilization Ordinance. 63 64 65 Ronald Lynch, 2412 Foothill Blvd, requested that witnesses with historical knowledge of the City's Rent Stabilization Ordinance be selected to defend the 66 pending lawsuit. 67 68 69 Robert Vanderford, 2412 Foothill Blvd, stated it is time to pull together with united front in defense of the pending lawsuit. 70 71 72 Jeff Bounsall, 414 Foothill Blvd, stated the need for the City Council and Planning 73 Commission to become more streamlined in order to promote future economic

development. He suggested that City staff be authorized to approve minor building

permits, and to reduce building permit fees by 25% to help stimulate future development.

Dennis McNay, **2653 Foothill Blvd**, provided his response to the recent boycott of local businesses as recommended by the Calistoga Police Officers Association.

ADOPTION OF MEETING AGENDA

It was MOVED by Councilmember Kraus and SECONDED by Councilmember Slusser to approve the Council Meeting Agenda. The Motion was carried unanimously.

COUNCIL IDEAS FOR DISCUSSION

Councilmember Kraus stated concerns regarding the impending Napa County Transportation and Planning Agency's (NCTPA) action on the proposed transportation sales tax measure. He requested that Mayor Gingles and Vice Mayor Dunsford (City NCTPA's representative) provide an update to Council regarding the proposed measure.

Vice Mayor Dunsford suggested that Paul Price, Napa County Transportation and Planning Agency Executive Director, provide a presentation at a future Council meeting on the proposed measure.

Councilmember Canning stated they are exploring hours NCTPA's Handyvan shuttle in the City to have expanded hours. It would run from 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM on a daily basis, and occasionally until 10:00 PM on weekends.

Mayor Gingles thanked the Rancho de Calistoga Mobilehome Park residents for attending tonight's Council meeting and expressing their concerns regarding the Rent Stabilization Ordinance issues. He reassured residents that the City's police and fire services will continue as usual.

Councilmember Slusser stated that she heard that there have been discussions about a proposed train service from Napa to St. Helena, and that it would be great to have the service come as far as Calistoga.

Mayor Gingles stated that the Mayor of the City of St. Helena brought the idea of train services from Napa to St. Helena to NCTPA; there will be feedback on this subject in the future, however funding is a big issue.

Public Works Director/City Engineer Takasugi introduced this item. He stated that with the yellow-curb loading zone in front of the Chamber of Commerce Visitors Center and Brannan's Grill on Washington Street large delivery trucks sometimes park near the parking lot drive aisle. He stated that the trucks at times obstruct the view of pedestrians walking east and vehicles turning into the parking drive aisle; staff proposes to paint an 18-foot red curb at this location to improve the sight distance.

It was MOVED by Councilmember Slusser and SECONDED by Councilmember Kraus to adopt <u>Resolution No. 2011-110</u> authorizing the Public Works Director to establish a No Stopping Zone on Washington Street at the entrance of the Fire Station parking lot. .
