MEETING NOTES Friday, October 21, 2011. City Hall Conference Room 1232 Washington Street

1 **The meeting was called to order at 10:30 a.m.**

2 Members present included Kerry Eddy, Lindsey Richardson, Shirley Blomquist,
3 David Moon-Wainwright and Aquatic and Recreation Manager Olivia Lemen.

5 **Adoption of the March 15th Meeting Minutes**

6 Committee member Eddy commented about the incorrect usage of
7 "Commissioner" vs "Committee Member" throughout the minutes. There was a
8 motion by Committee Member Moon-Wainwright, seconded by Committee
9 Member Eddy to approve the minutes as presented. The Motion was carried
10 unanimously.

12 **Review and discussion of 2011 attendance and budget**

13 Recreation Manager Lemen reviewed the staff report and provided explanations
14 to some of the numbers. There was dialog about swim lessons and the request
15 from the committee came up to see if the reports would separate Resident vs.
16 non-Residents –Lemen will report back at next meeting. Committee discussed
17 various opportunities to promote swim lessons and increase participation as well
18 as increase usage of the coupons available through the CCPP. There was also
19 discussion about increasing lap swimming during rec swim times.

20 **Review and discussion of 2011 survey**

21 Recreation Manager Lemen reminded committee members to help promote the
22 survey which closes on October 24th. There were currently a little more than ½ of
23 the responses from the year before.

24 **Suggestions and discussion for 2011 program offerings**

25 Committee Members would like to see a strategic plan for CPAC to help guide
26 future progress.

27 Committee Member Moon-Wainwright suggested a reduction of early morning
28 staffing by having lap swimmers pay ahead of time and attend on honor system.
29 He also suggested increased access to B and B's and Spas in town to purchase
30 passes to use and to make resident pricing available to out of town guests of

31 residents. He also requested all the brush be cut down below the Oak trees to
32 provide an unobstructed view of the Palisades from inside the pool.

33 Committee Member Eddy suggested that the pool have a standing column in one
34 of the local papers to help update community members of the weekly going-ons
35 at the pool. Also, she wanted to check to see if all the pools signs had been
36 placed. She felt the one located on mid-Washington was not close enough to the
37 Berry intersection to be a directional sign.
