BACKGROUND:

10 The City Council established objectives for the Fiscal Year 2008/2009 Community Enrichment Grant Program (CEG) through the adoption of Resolution No. 2008-013 11 12 (copy attached), and established a review subcommittee consisting of Councilmembers Kraus and Slusser, along with the City Manager and the City Clerk. 13

Staff sent out Community Enrichment Grant applications to the non-profit groups that applied in Fiscal Year 2008/2009 and received sixteen application requests seeking cash funding in the amount of \$37,342 for Fiscal Year 2008/2009. The 2008/2009 Fiscal Year budget includes cash funding for CEG at a \$25,000 level.

DISCUSSION:

The subcommittee met on April 8th to evaluate the CEG requests against the objectives outlined in Resolution No. 2008-013, and with the constraint of the established budget amount the subcommittee recognized the value of each of the requests, but was confronted with funding demands in excess of the budget available. The subcommittee chose to reduce some of the requests in an effort to provide funding of a meaningful level within the established budget limit; therefore not all applicants received the requested funding.

The conclusion of the evaluation by the subcommittee results in the following recommendation for funding:
