**BACKGROUND:** Pursuant to Election Code 10002, 10242, 10263, 10403 the City Council initiates the election process by adopting a Resolution calling and giving notice of the holding of the November 4, 2008 General Municipal Election, and requesting the Board of Supervisors of the County of Napa to permit the County Clerk and the County Elections Department to render certain services to the City of Calistoga. Pursuant to Election Code 12101-12102 the City Clerk shall publish once, a notice of General Municipal Election not earlier than the 127th nor later than the 113th day prior to the election (between June 20, 2008 and July 14, 2008).

18 19 FISCAL IMPACT: The estimated cost of the November 4, 2008 General Municipal Election is \$6,500. This estimate includes costs for ballots, advertising, publishing, County Election Clerk costs, etc.

## RESOLUTION NO. 2008-\_\_\_\_

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALISTOGA, COUNTY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, CALLING AND GIVING NOTICE OF THE HOLDING OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, THE 4<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF NOVEMBER 2008, FOR THE ELECTION OF CERTAIN OFFICERS OF SAID CITY AS REQUIRED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA RELATING TO GENERAL LAW CITIES, AND REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SAID COUNTY OF NAPA TO CONSOLIDATE SAID ELECTION WITH THE NOVEMBER 4, 2008 CONSOLIDATED GENERAL ELECTION AND PERMIT THE COUNTY ELECTIONS OFFICIAL TO RENDER CERTAIN SERVICES TO THE CITY OF CALISTOGA FOR SAID ELECTION

WHEREAS, Calistoga Municipal Code 2.06.050 stipulates that a General Municipal Election be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of even-numbered years; and

WHEREAS, the date of the next City election is November 4, 2008 for the election of two members of the City Council and a Mayor of the City of Calistoga, which need to be decided by the voters of the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Election Code sections 10002, 10242, 10263, 10403 the City Council initiates the election process by adopting a Resolution calling and giving notice of the holding of a General Municipal Election.

WHEREAS, Election Code 10261 allows the governing body of the jurisdiction to establish a central counting place; and

WHEREAS, certain actions are required in connection with said Election; and

WHEREAS, all necessary expenses in performing election services will be reimbursed by the City of Calistoga; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the City Council of the City of Calistoga does hereby resolve, declare and order as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California relating to General Law Cities, there shall be, and there is hereby called and ordered, held in the City of Calistoga, County of Napa, State of California, on Tuesday, November 4, 2008, a General Municipal Election for the purpose of electing a Mayor for the term of two years; and two (2) Members of the City Council for the term of four (4) years.

Page 2 of 3 SECTION 2. That notice of the time and place of holding said Election is hereby 31 given, and the City Clerk is hereby authorized to give such further or additional 32 notice of said Election in the time, form and manner as required by law. 33 34 SECTION 3. That the ballots to be used at said Election shall be, both as to form 35 and matter contained therein, such as may be required by law. 36 37 38 SECTION 4. That the City Clerk of said City is hereby authorized to procure and 39 furnish any and all official ballots, notices and printed matters that may be 40 necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct said Election, except as noted 41 herein. 42 43 SECTION 5. For the purposes of said Election, the City of Calistoga is hereby 44 divided into the following precincts: 343201, 343202, 343203, 343204, and 343205. 45 46 SECTION 6. That the City Council of the City of Calistoga does hereby request the 47 Napa County Board of Supervisors to consolidate the Municipal Election with the 48 49 November 4, 2008 Consolidated General Election and establish a Central Counting Precinct at the Napa County Election Division, 900 Coombs Street. 50 51 Room 256, Napa, California. 52 SECTION 7. That the City Council of the City of Calistoga does hereby request the 53 54 55

Napa County Board of Supervisors to authorize the County Elections Official to prepare and perform certain services for the City of Calistoga in relation to said consolidated Election:
