## CITY OF CALISTOGA PLANNING COMMISSION RESOLUTION PC 2012-04

A RESOLUTION FORWARDING A RECOMMENDATION TO THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE ADOPTION OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE LAND USE, COMMUNITY IDENTITY AND CIRCULATION ELEMENTS OF THE GENERAL PLAN FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE URBAN DESIGN PLAN CHARACTER AREAS

**WHEREAS,** the City of Calistoga is required by State law to prepare and adopt a General Plan for the long-term physical growth and development of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the General Plan is not sufficiently focused with respect to land use policies related to more immediate development and redevelopment interests and needs; and

WHEREAS, the Community Identity Element of the General Plan identifies the need to prepare an Urban Design Plan for the purpose of better articulating the expectations of the community for future development in key areas of the City; and

WHEREAS, an Urban Design Plan was prepared and adopted by the City Council as a planning feasibility study on January 19, 2010; and

WHEREAS, in June, 2011, the City Council directed staff to prepare necessary General Plan amendments for implementing the Character Area chapter of the Urban Design Plan; and

**WHEREAS,** staff has prepared amendments to the Land Use, Community Identity, and Circulation Elements of the General Plan necessary for implementing the Character Area chapter of the Urban Design Plan; and

WHEREAS, public hearings on the preliminary draft General Plan amendments were conducted before the Planning Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on August 24, 2011, and before the City Council at its regularly scheduled meeting of October 18, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, at its regularly scheduled meeting on October 18, 2011, the City Council directed staff to finalize the draft amendments and proceed with the formal adoption process; and

**WHEREAS,** the Planning Commission considered the proposed General Plan amendments at its regular meeting on February 22, 2012, and prior to taking action on the proposed update, received written and oral reports by the staff, and received public testimony; and

**WHEREAS**, the potential environmental impacts of the updated Housing Element were evaluated in an Initial Study that was prepared pursuant to the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and
