ISSUE: Solicitation and discussion of possible applications for funding under the 2012 State Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program.

RECOMMENDATION: Take public comments on possible CDBG Grant applications, discuss and provide direction to staff.

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: The Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) is a flexible program that provides communities with grants to address a wide range of unique community development needs. Activities eligible for funding through the CDBG program include: homeownership assistance and housing rehabilitation programs; public facility and public improvements projects (including public improvements in support of new housing construction); public service programs, planning studies, economic development business assistance and microenterprise activities. Eligible activities paid for with State CDBG funds must meet one or more of the three national objectives listed in CDBG Federal Statutes as follows: benefit to low income households or persons; elimination of slums and blight; or meeting an urgent community development need.

The purpose of this public hearing is to give citizens an opportunity to make their comments known regarding what types of eligible activities the City of Calistoga should consider applying for under the State CDBG program. A separate public hearing will be held to discuss and approve any application prior to submittal to the State.
