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32 **Calistoga Pool Rules and Policies/Reglas de la Piscina**

33 It is important to make sure you know of the rules and policies before your first
34 visit. A full copy of the pool rules is available on the city web site. The City of
35 Calistoga requests that you review these rules prior to your first visit so you can
36 be prepared to enjoy the facility:
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- 38 • Children 5 and under must have an adult in the water with them at all
39 times.
- 40 • Children under the age of 10 must be accompanied and supervised by
41 a responsible person age 16 or older at all times. Teens 16-18 years
42 of age may be limited to accompanying 2 children at one time.
- 43 • All swimmers are highly encouraged to shower before entering the
44 pool.
- 45 • Swimsuits and swim appropriate attire only. *No street clothes, cut-offs,*
46 *loose fitting T-shirts or skimpy swim wear such as g-string and thongs.*
- 47 • Small, soft pool toys are allowed with lifeguard approval. Please check

1 with the Head Lifeguard prior to use. Children may not use lap
2 swimming and exercise equipment.

- 3 • No floatation devices allowed, including lifejackets, float suits and
4 water wings.
- 5 • Children who are not 100% potty trained, must wear a swim diaper.
6 This includes any children who only need a diaper at night time to
7 sleep, so please plan ahead and bring them with you. Remind ALL
8 children to use the bathroom before and during use of the pool.
- 9 • Absolutely NO alcohol, smoking or glass containers are allowed within
10 the facility.
- 11 • The pool has a large lawn and picnic area. You are allowed to bring in
12 food. Please make sure that you do NOT bring any glass containers or
13 alcohol, they are not be allowed at any time. A limited snack menu is
14 also available for your convenience.
- 15 • Admission is charged to all visitors during open pool times regardless
16 of swimming or observing. Admission is not required for swim lesson
17 observers.

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
