# MEETING NOTES Friday, December 2, 2011. City Hall Conference Room 1232 Washington Street

#### The meeting was called to order at 10:45 a.m.

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### Adoption of the March 15<sup>th</sup> Meeting Minutes

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#### Review and discussion of 2011 End of Season Survey
