ISSUE: To consider a Resolution authorizing the use of Lake Street from Fair Way to Highway 29 for the Napa Valley Silverado Half Marathon and 5k April 22, 2012.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: Any event which requires closure of a Calistoga city street requires City Council approval. Furthermore each applicant must provide required insurance and comply with any terms or conditions applied to the permit.

- Enviro-Sports Productions, Inc has applied for a Special Event Permit for their Napa Valley Silverado Half Marathon and 5k. The event is planned for April 22, 2012 from 8:00AM – 12:00 PM. The event will include a foot race starting and ending a Calistoga
- 13 Jr./Sr. High School followed by an awards ceremony.
- The event planners are requesting a full closure of Lake Street from Fair Way to
- Highway 29 between the hours of 7:30-9:00 AM and then a partial closure with
- 16 controlled traffic from 9:00-11:30 AM. They have also requested a full closure of
- Silverado Trail from Highway 29 to Crystal Springs Road and California Highway Patrol
- has been contracted to provide traffic control for this section of the race. There are approximately 1000 visitors expected and approximately 100 volunteers at the event.
- 20 This closure will have a temporary impact on private resident access along Lake Street
- 21 and the event planners will be required for neighborhood notification with Calistoga
- 22 Police Department direction.

- If the Council authorizes these uses of public streets, staff will process the specific Special Event Permit and establish conditions of approval.
- FISCAL IMPACT: The use of public streets for special events has no significant fiscal impact on the City. The potential positive impact on local businesses and merchants depends on the success the event has in drawing visitors to the community.
