RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALISTOGA, COUNTY OF NAPA AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE CALISTOGA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE FOR MARKETING AND PROMOTIONAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, Calistoga was founded as a resort community and enjoys and depends upon a high rate of tourism; and WHEREAS, tourism constitutes a major industry in Calistoga, and the City receive a significant portion of its revenues from taxes (Transient Occupancy Tax) generated by the tourist industry; and WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the need to aggressively promote the community in order to maintain and enhance our attractiveness as a tourist destination; and WHEREAS, the City of Council has contracted with the Calistoga Chamber of Commerce in the past for community promotional services; and WHEREAS, while the City Council finds that such a relationship has been beneficial to the community, the City Council desires to continue to promote focused marketing and promotional strategies in the future. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Calistoga City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager is to enter into a professional services agreement as set forth in Exhibit A to this resolution with the Calistoga Chamber of Commerce to provide destination marketing and promotional services in the amount of \$252,000 with the potential for another \$50,000 to be disbursed should Transient Occupancy Tax revenues exceed the budgeted 3.5% growth projection.
