ISSUE: Consideration of a Resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a funding agreement with Napa County Housing Authority in the amount of \$10,000 to support the Napa Valley Farmworker Housing Centers' Fiscal Year 2012-2013 operating budget.

> BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: The Napa County Housing Authority owns and operates three farmworker housing centers in Napa County (the River Ranch Center on Silverado Trail near St. Helena, the Calistoga Center on North St. Helena Highway, and the Mondavi Center on Silverado Trail near Yountville). The Napa County Housing Authority budget to operate these centers is approximately \$1.2 million.

> Farmworker center operations are funded through three primary sources: direct rent (\$12 per person per night) received by the farmworker tenants, proceeds from the special property tax (\$10 per acre) imposed on vineyard property in Napa County (County Service Area #4), and revenue generated at the centers related to phone and laundry facility use. In addition to these sources of funding, operations have been funded through three grants received from Auction Napa Valley (\$100,000 each) and by financial contributions from the cities of American Canyon, Calistoga, St. Helena and Yountville. The County contributes \$190,000 annually to administer the program and has utilized its Affordable Housing Fund to fund repairs and shortfalls in the

FISCAL IMPACT: Funding has been allocated for this agreement from the Special Revenue Fund (Community Development Fund (39)) Budget for Fiscal Year 2012-2013.
