## **Authorizing Agreement No. 0392-02**

## (2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment and Restatement)

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to encourage the economic vitality of the community through well considered development which is in keeping with the community character and which enhances the amenities available to residents and visitors to Calistoga; and

WHEREAS, on December 15, 2009, the City entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Bounsall Family to guide the development of the Bounsall properties located at 414 Foothill Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, on August 3, 2010, the City executed an amendment and restated the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) extending the term to December 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Bounsall Family submitted a letter on April 16, 2012 requesting an amendment to their MOU for the purpose of extending the term of the MOU and removing "General Plan Amendments" from the list of City Approvals identified in Section 6(A) of the MOU; and

**WHEREAS**, an amendment and extension is necessary for allowing the Bounsall Family sufficient time for the submittal of a conceptual review application for Planning Commission's consideration and to proceed through the formal entitlement process including a Development Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed amendment removing "General Plan Amendments" from the list of City Approvals is appropriate since a General Plan is no longer necessary based upon the recent General Plan Amendments resulting from the implementation of the Urban Design Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, it is understood by all parties to this MOU that any development project for the subject property is subject to the normal environmental review and public hearing land use entitlement process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Calistoga City Council hereby authorizes the Interim City Manager to execute an amendment to the MOU in
