WHEREAS, in accordance with applicable provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), an initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared by NCTPA for the Countywide Bicycle Plan and the

The mitigated negative Declaration was certified by NCTPA on May 16, 2012 with the adoption of the Countywide Bicycle Plan and City Bicycle Plan; and
