# BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

The enabling ordinance of Measure A identifies eligible projects in Calistoga as follows:

- 1. Stabilization and enhancement of Kimball Reservoir which shall be for the purpose of flood protection and water supply reliability; and
- 2. Flood protection and drainage improvements in the Grant Street area and other critical areas to protect residents and businesses from flooding.

On November 18, 2003, the City of Calistoga entered into an agreement with the Napa County Flood Protection and Watershed Improvement Authority (NCFPWIA) to provide

- 24 Measure A funds to pay for the engineering expenses of the Kimball Reservoir
- 25 Maintenance Dredging Program. On April 19, 2005, the Council approved an
- amendment to that agreement in the amount of \$85,408 and an additional amendment
- 27 on October 4, 2005 to fund the storm drain improvements that were included in the
- 28 Grant Street Reconstruction Project. On July 5, 2006, the Council approved
- 29 Amendment No. 4 to extend the agreement to June 30, 2008.

The Grant Street Reconstruction Project has been completed and reimbursements have been received. The Kimball Maintenance Dredging Program engineering has been partially completed and all costs expended to date have been reimbursed by Measure A.

The attached Amendment No. 5 to the agreement with NCFPWIA would extend the agreement for two years and requests additional funds in the amount of \$16,000 to replace a culvert that has collapsed at Fischer Street and Lake Street. All other conditions of that agreement would remain in effect. The attached resolution would approve the amendment and authorize the City manager to execute it contingent approval by the NCFPWIA.
