<u>ISSUE</u>: The Council is requested, in response to a petition for a referendum against Resolution 2012-062, a general plan amendment, approving a Planned Development Overlay and Planned Development Goals for the Enchanted Resorts Properties, to first acknowledge the County's certification that the referendum petition against the resolution contains the requisite number of valid signatures; and second, reconsider Resolution 2012-062 and either repeal Resolution 2012-062, or submit Resolution 2012-062 to the voters at a special election to be held on March 5, 2013. If the Council determines to submit the resolution to the voters, the Council should also consider whether it desires to provide for the designation of Council Members to prepare arguments in favor of the resolution.

RECOMMENDATION:

- (1) By motion, accept the County Certification that the Referendum Petition against Resolution 2012-062 has the Requisite Number of Valid Signatures;
- (2) Adopt a Resolution Submitting the Resolution to the Voters at a Special Election to be held March 5, 2013 and Requesting the Board of Supervisors of Napa County to Consolidate said Election with the March 5, 2013 Consolidated Election; and

(3) Designate one or two Council Members (Canning and Kraus) to prepare ballot arguments in favor of the Measure.

BACKGROUND: On August 21, 2012, the City Council adopted "Resolution 2012-062, A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Calistoga, County of Napa, State of California, Approving an Amendment to the General Plan Overlay Districts Map, Figure LU-6 to Include those Properties generally located at 515 Foothill Boulevard (011-310-031 through 011-310-041 and 011-310-044; 011-320-007; 011-320-039 through 011-320-069; and 011-310-024) within Planned Development Overlay Designation and Establishing Associated Planned Development Goals for the Enchanted Resorts Properties." On September 20, 2012, community members delivered a Referendum petition against Resolution 2012-062 to the City Clerk. The County Elections Division found the Referendum against Resolution 2012-062 sufficient.

When a referendum petition has qualified, the City Council is required by state law to reconsider the ordinance (or in this case a resolution). The City Council must either: (1) repeal the resolution against which the petition is filed; or (2) submit the resolution to the voters, either at the next regular municipal election occurring not less than 88 days after the order of the legislative body, or at a special election not less than 88 days after the order of the legislative body. (CA Gov. Code Sec. 9241).

DISCUSSION:

Staff is recommending that Resolution 2012-062 be sent to the voters to consider at a March 5, 2013, special election. The Enchanted Resorts resort and residential project will consist of a 110 resort hotel units, 20 residence club units, 13 custom residences, public restaurant and bar, event facilities, spa and swimming pools, and parking and support facilities. It is located on 88 acres located in the hills above 515 Foothill Boulevard.

The project took over two years to go through the formal city approval process. The complexity of issues and the degree of controversy should be subject to a community wide discussion in the ensuing months leading to the March election. The following is the recommended language for the Measure:

Shall Resolution 2012-062, a general plan amendment approved by the City Council to establish a planned development overlay	YES	
and certain planned development goals for the property generally located at 515 Foothill Boulevard, Calistoga, which will allow the development of the Enchanted Resorts resort and residential project, be adopted?	NO

A referendum is a different process from an initiative and after action on the referendum will not require further submittal to the voters for future amendments. If the Council rescinds the resolution or the resolution is submitted to the voters and the voters do not approve the resolution, the same or a similar resolution cannot be adopted for one year. (CA Gov. Code Sec. 9241.) If the resolution is approved, it is treated like any other municipal resolution and may be amended by the Council at a later date. (CA Constit. Art 2, Section 10.)

Should the Council decide to adopt the resolution calling a Special Election, one or two Council members may be designated to prepare arguments in favor of the measure. It is recommended that Councilmembers Canning and Kraus be chosen to prepare the arguments, as it is certain that they will remain on the Council after the November election results are certified.

FISCAL IMPACT: Placing the Measure on the ballot for a Special Election could cost up to \$15,000 to \$20,000
