## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABATE AND REMOVE AN ABANDONED, WRECKED, DISMANTLED, OR INOPERATIVE VEHICLE OR PARTS THEREOF AS A PUBLIC NUISANCE

As the owner shown on the last equalized assessment roll of the land located at 507 Washington St. (APN# 011-260-040) ,you are hereby notified that the undersigned pursuant to Section 10.59.090 of the Calistoga Municipal Code has determined that there exists upon said lot abandoned, wrecked, dismantled, or inoperative vehicles (or parts of), to wit:

- 1. A white Datsun 510, California license 633AOG
- 2. A white "Week-N-Der" mobile home, RV ID #27671
- 3. A green/white camper trailer

which constitutes a public nuisance pursuant to the provision of Section 10.52.010 of the Calistoga Municipal Code.

You are hereby notified to abate said nuisance by the removal of said vehicles (or said parts of vehicles) within 10 days from the date of mailing of this notice, and upon your failure to do so the same will be abated and removed by the City of Calistoga and the costs thereof, together with administrative costs, assessed to you as owner of the land on which said vehicles (or said parts of vehicles) is located.

As owner of the land on which said vehicles (or said parts of a vehicles) are located, you are hereby notified that you may, within 10 days after the mailing of this notice of intention, request a public hearing and if such a request is not received by the City Clerk of the City of Calistoga within such 10-day period, the Chief of Police shall have the authority to abate and remove said vehicle (or said parts of a vehicle) as a public nuisance and assess the costs as aforesaid without a public hearing. You may submit a sworn written statement within such 10-day period denying responsibility for the presence of said vehicle (or said parts of a vehicle) on said land, with your reasons for denial, and such statement shall be construed as a request for hearing at which your presence is not required. You may appear in person at any hearing requested by you or the owner of the vehicle or, in lieu thereof, may present a sworn written statement as aforesaid in time for consideration at such hearing.
