Resort at Indian Springs Expansion – Consideration of a proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration, Conditional Use Permit (U 2011-11), Design Review (DR 2011-09) and Development Agreement (DA 2011-01) requested by John Merchant, on behalf of Resort at Indian Springs, LLC, allowing 75 additional guest rooms, a restaurant, event building, gym & yoga studio and hotel registration building. Landscaping, new parking areas, driveways and pedestrian pathways will also be developed. On and off site water, sewer, recycled water and storm drainage improvements

will be installed to serve this project located on the 16 acre site at 1712 Lincoln Avenue (APN 011-340-019) within the "CC-DD", Community Commercial - Design District.
