BACKGROUND: On August 21, 2007, the City Council considered the proposed Ordinance recommended by the Planning Commission on August 8, 2007 (Attachment 3). After lengthy discussion, the City Council referred this item back to the Planning Commission for further thoughts regarding membership qualifications and boundaries for membership. On September 26, 2007, this matter was presented to the Planning Commission. A copy of the Planning Commission Staff Report is attached to this report for Council review (Attachment 2).

The Commission was in agreement that Panel candidates be drawn from a 50 mile radius of the City of Calistoga in order to increase the pool of well qualified applicants. However, the Commission reiterated their concern that Panel members should be familiar with the Calistoga community and our design sensitivities. They therefore recommended that a preference be established for qualified candidates with the Calistoga Joint Unified School District boundaries.

# 29 Panel Qualifications (Section 17.06.35B.2) Proposed Amendment:

The Commission recommended that the Panel membership not be limited to licensed design professionals, and that unlicensed designed professional, planners and preservationists be eligible to participate. The Commission wished to insure that the Panel will have a broad and diverse area of interest and expertise in membership.

# Other Recommendations:

The Commission also recommended that a more formal interview process be considered for Panel members. The process should occur prior to the regular Council meeting at which the appointment is made and should include participation by the Chair of the Planning Commission and the Director of Planning and Building Department. Furthermore, the Commission intends on requiring a member from the Planning Commission to attend all Design Advisory Panel meetings to serve as a Commissioner liaison to the Panel. The Commission intends to serve on a rotation schedule throughout the year.

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW: This action has been reviewed pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and determined that this activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects, which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment, and where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the action being contemplated, a minor revision to the Design Review Ordinance will have any impact on the environment [Section 15061(b)(3)].

<u>FISCAL IMPACT</u>: No significant additional fiscal impacts would occur to the City as a result of setting up a Design Advisory Panel to review future projects. Limited staff assistance to the Panel is anticipated with modest staff costs. The City Council has adopted a fee schedule for processing of development applications, as well as City implementation of a cost recovery program to account for staff time and/or direct costs.
