# MEETING NOTES Thursday December 13, 2012 10:00 am Calistoga Community Center 1307 Washington Street

# 1 The meeting was called to order at 10:04 a.m.

2 Committee Members present included Kerry Eddy (left at 10:45), David Moon-

Wainwright, Shirley Blomquist, and Recreation Manager Olivia Lemen. Jose

4 Sanchez, pool staff was also present. Committee Member Lindsey Richardson

arrived at 10:15 am (left at 11:15).

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# **November 8th minutes**

8 Motion to approve minutes by Committee Member Eddy, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Moon-

9 Wainwright. Passed unanimously.

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# **Public Comment**

12 None

# 13 Review amendment, discuss and adopt the amended CPAC bylaws.

- 14 Committee Member Eddy noted the typo in the staff report on lines 11-14 which
- 15 indicated that CPAC is "designed to provide a forum for the
- discussion/consideration of matters related to recreation, senior and youth issues,
- 17 community beautification, park development, etc." This is not accurate. Per
- resolution 2010-067, "CPAC is designed as a forum to provide input and develop a
- series of recommendations for improvements to programs and operations for the
- 20 Calistoga Community Pool to better serve all affected parties." It was also noted
- the typo on line 30 which indicated "CRC" bylaws instead of "CPAC".
- 22 It was noted by Recreation Manager Lemen that the additional language with the
- 23 Secretary creating the agenda with input from the Chair is consistent with how all
- other City meetings are run. It was also noted that the Bylaws are approved by
- 25 resolution so once CPAC approves the amendment, it must go to council for
- approval. It will most likely go on the January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2013 City Council meeting.
- 27 Committee Member Eddy made a motion to approve the additional bylaw
- 28 regarding the creation of the agenda, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Committee Member Moon-
- 29 Wainwright. Passed unanimously.
- 30 Nominate and elect Chair and Vice Chair for CPAC.

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- 31 Recreation Manger Lemen nominated David Moon-Wainwright for the position of
- 32 Chair and Lindsey Richardson as Vice-Chair. Both accepted nomination. Voting
- was unanimous in favor for both. 33
- 34 There was discussion about the committee being more accessible to the
- 35 community and for there to be clear lines of communication. Committee Member
- 36 Moon-Wainwright offered to provide an email address which can be published on
- 37 the web site so that community members can reach him directly as well as
- 38 through city Staff. Recreation Manager Lemen also offered to write a letter to the
- 39 editor at the beginning of the new year to announce some the changes coming
- 40 out of the survey and provide information on how to give feedback year round
- 41 through the committee.

#### 42 Continuation of discussion and review of the Community Pool Survey for <u> 2012</u> 43

- 44 There was discussion about the lack of water aerobics equipment. Recreation
- 45 Manager Lemen mentioned that CCPP generously provided a grant to purchase
- equipment in the summer of 2010. With that grant, more hand bar bells were 46
- purchased to create a complete class set. While we have enough equipment for 47
- 48 every person, the participants now prefer the newer equipment and do not want
- 49 the older equipment. Also, looking into adding another instructor to bring some
- 50 variety including possibility of Agua Zumba or some other dance type aerobics.
- 51 Committee Member Eddy recommend contacting Jill Hoff as a possibility.
- 52 The comments regarding mid day lap swimming were discussed. Based on
- previous attendance numbers for lap swim, it is suggested that this be continued 53
- 54 in the spring/fall and even in the pre- and post- seasons. Recreation Manager
- 55 also noted that there will be a Masters team for 2013 as well as a youth team to
- 56 provide more of a coaching environment.
- 57 There was discussion about the cleanliness and chlorine issues for the facility.
- 58 Recreation Manager assured committee these will be resolved before this
- 59 upcoming season.

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- 60 Recreation Manager mentioned that staff are already making some programming 61
- changes based on the survey feedback including:
  - Family Nights in 2013 will be "Family Float Nights" to provide families an opportunity to bring in inflatable's during special times;
    - The addition of a Masters Swim time and a Youth Swim team time:
- Improvements/changes to Swim Instructor training and performance 65 66 expectations;
  - Additional staff training components to weekly staff meetings to assist Lifeguard and office staff at handling specific situations and empowering them to solve problems and improve service to the community;
  - 2013 pool banner dates are confirmed as 5/28-6/21 across Lincoln Ave.

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- 71 Additional discussion around Mr. Sherman's survey and comments. Chair Moon-
- Wainwright and Recreation Manager Lemen will follow up and provide a personal
- 73 response at Mr. Sherman's request.
- 74 It was recommended to put another letter to the editor in the paper in the spring
- about lap swimming and pool etiquette to educate the community.

# 76 Review and discuss St. Helena Waves request for pool usage and make

### 77 <u>recommendation.</u>

- 78 There was a lot of discussion around the entire upcoming season schedule and
- 79 the various impacts to the Calistoga community. Both as a result of the Waves
- 80 request and with the shut down the St. Helena pool in general. Recreation
- 81 Manager indicated that any major community impact such as a weekend closure
- would need City Manager/City Council approval. CPAC will flush out details and
- 83 make a recommendation. The benefits and draw backs were discussed.
- 84 Committee Member Moon Wainwright felt strongly about Calistoga being
- 85 neighborly and supporting the Waves where possible. It was recommended that
- 86 the item go back to Recreation Manager to research loss of revenue impact for
- 87 swim meet closure and to propose some alternative practice times which do not
- 88 impact prime program time as originally requested.

- 91 options (Committee Member Moon-Wainwright requested to review PGE costs
- 92 for pool)
- 93 2013 Pool Schedule
