ISSUE: Consideration of a Resolution declaring the results of the Special Municipal Election held in the City of Calistoga, on March 5, 2013.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: The City of Calistoga conducted its Special Election on March 5, 2013 to address the Enchanted Resorts referendum (Ballot Measure C). In accordance with State law, the election process officially begins not less than 88 days after the City Council calls for the election, and ends at least 30 days subsequent to the election when the City Council declares the results of the election. This report includes: 1) a general description of the election process; 2) a description of the official canvass; and 3) a summary of the results of the election.

The Election Process

On November 20, 2012 the City Council adopted Resolution 2012-078 requesting that the Napa County Elections Department hold a special election to address the referendum on the Enchanted Resorts general plan amendment which was adopted by the City Council on August 21, 2012 (pursuant to Elections Code section 9214 b).

During the period from September 20, 2012 through March 5, 2013 the City Clerk's office engaged in the following activities: 1) published and posted notices as

- required by state law; 2) assisted petitioners with campaign finance disclosure requirements; 3) assisted and reviewed a petition for referendum, arguments for and against the ballot measure and rebuttals to same; and 4) publicized the election.
- The County conducted the election, prepared the certification and the canvass of returns of the election pursuant to Elections Code 10418.

- The official canvass was conducted by the Napa County Elections Department during the period February 4, 2013 through March 7, 2013 for ballot Measure C.
