WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Calistoga, on January 4, 2005, adopted an Ordinance #616, established Chapter 19.02 Growth Management System of the Calistoga Municipal Code applicable to development in all zoning districts;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Calistoga, on September 6, 2005 adopted Ordinance #624 amending Chapter 19.02 Growth Management System of Calistoga Municipal Code to clarify and improve program implementation;

WHEREAS, the Growth Management System was found to be consistent with the City's General Plan, which establishes growth management policies based on a desire to restrict population growth to no more than 1.35% per year and to balance growth with the availability of essential public facilities and services;

WHEREAS, the Growth Management System established annual allocations for residential and non-residential growth and set forth a process for ranking and selecting individual development proposals in instances where the amount of residential or nonresidential development being proposed exceeds available allocations in a given year;

WHEREAS, the Growth Management System established a list of general development objectives for awarding allocations to residential and non-residential development and further requires the Planning Commission each year to review and recommend to the City Council, depending on conditions at the time, which general development objectives should be or not be included for the upcoming allocation; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City of Calistoga, at its regular meeting of July 9, 2008, considered as one of its items of business.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Calistoga Planning Commission that based on the Purpose and Objectives of the Growth Management System, the Planning Commission forwards its recommendation to the City Council the following General Development Objectives for the 2009 Growth Management Allocation.
