SUBJECT: Pre- season pass sales and post-season opportunities

ISSUE: Review the Pre- and explore Post- season opportunities for 2013.

RECOMMENDATION: Receive presentation, discuss and make recommendation.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

In January of 2013 CPAC discussed the opportunities for the pre-season schedule and provided Staff to develop a schedule within the following parameters:

- Keep required number of people to open between 60 and 70
- Price point \$60-\$65
- Dates April 8th May 10th
- Keep schedule as last year and add as many early morning hours as possible within the parameters

The final schedule added morning lap swimming Monday, Wednesdays and Fridays in addition to the evening hours on those same days, water exercise on Tuesday and Thursday evenings and both water exercise and lap swimming on Saturdays. The schedule required 52 pre-season passes to be pre-sold to guarantee the City could recover the costs of the pre-season.

- As of April 28th, 56 passes were sold. These sales where 12 less than the preseason (68 total) of 2012 and were much slower to come in. In the post-season of 2012, only 57 were sold. These numbers need to be considered as we continue to explore the viability of these pre- and post- season opportunities.
- The regular season is scheduled to close on September 15th. CPAC should begin exploring various ideas on a viable way expand the pool season without any additional financial burden on the City. Without full cost recovery, the post-season will not be able to operate.
