

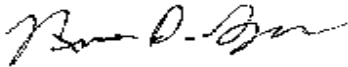

**SUBJECT:** Amendment No. 1 to the Joint Powers Agreement for use of Medical Cache Trailers

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2 **ISSUE:** Consideration of a Resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute  
3 Amendment No. 1 to the Joint Powers Agreement (JPA) for the use of Medical Cache  
4 Trailers.  
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6 **RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt Resolution.  
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8 **BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:** In 2004 the County Health and Human Services  
9 Department was successful in obtaining a grant for the acquisition of three Medical  
10 Cache Trailers. The medical cache trailers are located in American Canyon, City of  
11 Napa and the California Department of Forestry Headquarters at Hwy. 29 and Big Tree  
12 Road. The three trailers are stocked with emergency medical supplies including  
13 bandaging and splinting materials that would be needed in a major emergency or  
14 disaster. The City has access to all three of the trailers in the event of an emergency  
15 and not just the one located in this part of the County. The JPA was developed to  
16 provide that a proportional share of the upkeep would be distributed to each agency.  
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18 On or about January 1, 2006 the participating Jurisdictions which include Calistoga,  
19 Napa, St. Helena, and the American Canyon Fire Protection District, entered into a Joint  
20 Powers Agreement (JPA) with Napa County to provide for the maintenance and use of  
21 Medical Cache Trailers.  
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23 Each of the Jurisdictions have agreed to make this Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement  
24 in order to update Exhibit A, "Description of Medical Cache Trailers and Conditions of

25 Operation” and Exhibit B, “Costs” to provide that the ALS Ambulance franchisee shall  
26 assume responsibility to rotate and replace expired medical cache trailer equipment,  
27 and to allow for the purchase of new tires using the “Major Repairs” fund.  
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29 **FISCAL IMPACT:** The annual fee for the City of Calistoga’s participation is \$200.
