1 **RESOLUTION NO. 2013 - XXX** 2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CALISTOGA 3 AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO FILE THE STORM WATER NOTICE OF 4 INTENT (NOI) TO THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD'S ORDER 5 NO. 2013-0001-DWQ NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION 6 SYSTEM (NPDES) GENERAL PERMIT NO.CAS000004 WASTE DISCHARGE 7 REQUIREMENTS (WDRS) FOR STORM WATER DISCHARGES FROM 8 MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER 9 SYSTEMS (GENERAL PERMIT), ALSO KNOWN AS THE PHASE II NPDES PERMIT 10 11 12 WHEREAS, the Federal Clean Water Act (CWA) establishes the basic structure 13 for regulating discharges of pollutants into waters of the United States; and 14 15 WHEREAS, the CWA was amended in 1987 to address nonpoint source 16 pollution, thereby requiring the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to issue 17 National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits for storm water 18 discharges; and 19 20 WHEREAS, on December 8, 1999, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) 21 promulgated regulations under the authority of the CWA establishing Phase II of the 22 NPDES storm water program, thereby requiring municipalities serving populations less 23 than 100,000 to implement a storm water management program as a means to control 24 polluted discharges from their municipal separate storm sewer systems; and 25 26 WHEREAS, the U.S. EPA delegates NPDES permitting authority to the California 27 State Water Resources Control Board (State Board); and 28 29 WHEREAS, on April 30, 2003, the State Board adopted Water Quality Order No. 2003-005-DWQ, NPDES General Permit CAS000004 Waste Discharge Requirements 30 31 for Storm Water Discharges from Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems

("Phase II Permit") to comply with Clean Water Act; and

WHEREAS, in 2003, the City of Calistoga applied for and obtained coverage for City of Calistoga under the State Board's Phase II Permit; and

WHEREAS, the City of Calistoga is currently covered by the State Board's 2003 Phase II Permit; and

WHEREAS, on February 5, 2013, the State Board adopted a revised Phase II Permit, which goes into effect on July 1, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the City of Calistoga is required to apply for coverage under the new Phase II Permit by the effective date of the Permit: and

EREAS , the application for coverage, known as the Notice of Intent (NOI), gned by a Legally Responsible Person (LRP) who is an executive officer or cted official of the designated municipality; and
EREAS, the LRP is responsible for reviewing, validating and certifying the curacy and correctness and submitting it electronically using the Storm Water cation, Reporting, and Tracking System (SMARTS) by July 1, 2013; and
EREAS , the applicable NPDES permit fee, jurisdiction boundary map, and document noting overall program planning and identification of all Permit its and responsible implementing parties must be submitted with the NOI;
EREAS , through the SMARTS application process the LRP may assign one ally Authorized Representatives (DARs) to certify and submit annual reports f the LRP.
V, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Calistoga hereby:
Authorizes the City Manager to serve as the Legally Responsible Person to apply for coverage under the Phase II Permit on behalf of the City of by electronically submitting a Notice of Intent via SMARTS. This on extends to other actions that may be necessary to complete and submit
Authorizes the City Manager to assign one or more Duly Authorized atives to certify and submit annual reports on behalf of the City Manager.
Authorizes the City Manager to submit the applicable NPDES permit fee in of \$4,852.10 with the NOI.
