BACKGROUND: Larry Kromann, Calistoga Affordable Housing (CAH), has submitted the attached letter on city housing fees. In this report Mr. Kromann outlines the need for affordable housing in Calistoga both in the present and with new resort development. He also discusses the lack of funding for affordable housing at the present. He proposes potential solutions which includes the 56 unit affordable family apartment project which is presently under review by the Planning Department. He also recommends that we make a formal request to Napa County to discuss how we might work together (along with CAH) to address affordable housing needs, including a parcel located on lower Washington Street that is under contract with CAH. He believes that the potential exists for Napa County to contribute funds for this affordable housing development.

Staff notes that the city of Calistoga is not behind in its legal requirement for housing development. 24 very low and low-income units have already been constructed during the 2007-2014 period and the City's certified Housing Element includes more than adequate sites for our remaining regional housing need. The previously mentioned 56 unit apartment project will bring us will beyond our legal requirement for lower income housing in Calistoga.
