RECOMMENDATION:

Receive presentation and adopt the Resolution establishing program objectives and to select the Council sub-committee members.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

Eleven years ago the City Council created the Community Enrichment Grant Program (Enrichment Grants) as a means of more directly providing funding to non-profit activities, which provide benefit to the community.

Staff proposes that we follow the same practice as in previous years and commence the process for the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 budget cycle. Staff advertised this opportunity for Fiscal Year 2013-2014 to various local non-profit groups. The deadline for applications to be submitted is Friday, August 9, 2013. The 2013/2014 Fiscal Year budget includes cash funding for enrichment grants at a \$5,000 level.
