Consideration of a use permit extension allowing a new winery within an existing 2

industrial building located at 865 Silverado Trail

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

- On May 22, 2013, the Planning Commission adopted Resolution 2013-16 approving a
- use permit allowing a new winery within an existing industrial building at 865 Silverado 6
- Trail. Since this approval, the applicant decided not to locate there and the property owner
- has been actively pursuing a new winery tenant. As such, more time is needed to execute
- a lease with the new tenant and secure the necessary permits to construct the winery.
- Although another tenant (i.e., Barrel Builders) has occupied a portion of the building 10
- (Suite C), there has not been any development on this property that is inconsistent with 11
- the approved project and the project remains consistent with the General Plan and 12
- Zoning Code. The winery would be located in Suite D, which is vacant and still remains 13
- available for lease. 14
- As a result, staff recommends that a one year time extension be granted in order to give
- the owner additional time to find a tenant. The Calistoga Municipal Code allows the 16
- granting of extensions for a period or periods of time not to exceed one year after the 17
- initial one-year approval period. 18
