ISSUE: To Approve the Display of a Non-Governmental Flag on City Property During the Last Week of June, 2014.

RECOMMENDATION: By motion, approve the display of the Rainbow Flag, a Non-Governmental Flag, on the City ceremonial flag pole during the last week of June, 2014, should the flag pole be installed by that time.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: On June 3, 2014, the Calistoga City Council adopted a resolution allowing the display of certain Non-Governmental flags on City-owned flag poles which are not otherwise dedicated to the display of the National, California and/or City flags.

The Mayor and/or a member of the City Council may submit a request to the City Manager in writing to display a Non-Governmental Flag on a ceremonial flagpole in conjunction with official actions, ceremonial items, or proclamations of the City Council.

With approval of the Non-Governmental Flag Policy the Council authorized the City Manager to have a new, ceremonial flag pole installed on City property. Staff has ordered a 25 foot high flag pole (to be reimbursed by private donations) and has found a site near the Community Center in which to install the flag pole (see Attachment 3).

On June 11, 2014, Mayor Canning received a request from a local resident requesting that the City display the Rainbow Flag during the last week of June 2014, to celebrate Gay Pride Week. In response, Mayor Canning has issued a proclamation declaring June as LGBT Pride Month for Council consideration. Mayor Canning has also

requested that the Council approve the display of the Rainbow Flag during the last week of June, 2014 on the ceremonial flag pole, should it be installed by that time.
