ISSUE: To adopt 2013-14 Year End Operating and Capital Budget adjustments.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution Approving Operating and Capital Improvement Budget Adjustments for Fiscal Year 2013-14

BACKGROUND:

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On June 18, 2013, the Fiscal Year 2013-14 budget was adopted by the City Council. This budget contained significant reductions in expenditures to achieve a balanced budget.

On February 18, 2014 staff presented at the regular Council meeting several budget adjustments for Fiscal Year 2013-14 based on the determination by the City Manager that these adjustments were essential to the City's operations. The City Council approved the budget adjustments to the City of Calistoga's Operating and Capital Improvement Budget for Fiscal Year 2013-14.

The attached resolution addresses budget adjustments for several capital projects that were not undertaken as was anticipated due to changes in priorities, scope of projects or lack of staff resources. Several capital projects that were not undertaken in FY 13-14 have been included in the FY 14-15 budget.
