**ISSUE**: To consider a Resolution authorizing 2014/2015 Community Enrichment Grant Awards.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt Resolution.

**BACKGROUND:** The City Council established objectives for the Fiscal Year 2014/2015 Community Enrichment Grant Program (CEG) through the adoption of Resolution No. 2014-065 (copy attached), and established a review subcommittee consisting of Councilmember Kraus and Councilmember Lopez-Ortega.

Staff sent out Community Enrichment Grant applications to non-profit groups and received six (6) application requests seeking cash funding in the amount of \$10,950.00 for Fiscal Year 2014/2015. The 2014/2015 Fiscal Year budget includes cash funding for CEG at a \$5,000 level.

## DISCUSSION:

The subcommittee met on August 15, 2014 to evaluate the CEG requests against the objectives outlined in Resolution No. 2014-065, and with the constraint of the established budget amount the subcommittee recognized the value of each of the requests, but was confronted with funding demands in excess of the budget available. The subcommittee chose to reduce some of the requests in an effort to provide funding of a meaningful level within the established budget limit; therefore not all applicants received the requested funding.

## **OPTION I**

The conclusion of the evaluation by the subcommittee for Option I uses budgeted funds and results in the following recommendation for funding:

# **OPTION II**

An alternate recommendation by the subcommittee would allow funding of most of the requests which would bring the Community Enrichment Grants to a total of \$10,000. This would require a budget adjustment of an additional \$5,000 from the undesignated General Fund. If approved the recommended funding is listed as follows:
