- 33 There was discussion about fees and the suggestion came up to reduce the
- multi-visit pass to an 80% cost of 10 daily visits (currently 90%) to encourage
- 35 additional usage.
- 36 It was also suggested to clarify the language which will go into the activity guide
- and marketing materials regarding the pre-season passes to make it easier to
- 38 understand for the community.
- 39 The lap swim and water exercise times were discussed at length and it was
- 40 recommended to add the mid-day lap swimming time in during the fall schedule
- 41 and reduce the evening lap swimming hours since the weather is so nice in the
- 42 fall. The spring and fall mid-day hours were eliminated from last years schedule
- 43 based on usage, lap swimming comments on the survey and budgetary
- restrictions on number of programming hours.
- 45 The Youth Swim Club was discussed and it was recommended to add a
- Calistoga hosted meet at the end of the season for the kids to have something to
- 47 look forward to.
- The rules were reviewed and language changes were recommended to make the
- 49 showering statement stronger.
