BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

The Governor's Office of Emergency Services, State OES, in conjunction with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) provides assistance to local governments for the development and execution of emergency management programs and for disaster relief funding following emergencies/disasters. To be eligible for disaster relief funding an agency must have an Emergency Management Program and designate agents authorized to execute applications and agreements on behalf of the agency.

The City of Calistoga has maintained an Emergency Management Program since 1985 and in 2002 adopted Resolution 2002-137 designating the City Manager, Police Chief and Emergency Program Coordinator as Agents for the City of Calistoga.
