- 8 **BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION**: Any event which requires closure of a Calistoga city street requires City Council approval. Furthermore each applicant must provide required insurance and comply with any terms or conditions applied to the permit.
- 11 Enviro-Sports Productions, Inc has applied for a Special Event Permit for their Napa
- 12 Valley Harvest Half Marathon, 10K and 5k. The event is planned for November 9, 2014
- 13 from 8:00AM 12:00 PM. The event will include a foot race starting and ending a
- 14 Calistoga Jr./Sr. High School followed by an awards ceremony.
- 15 The event planners are requesting a full closure of the following streets between the
- hours of 7:30-9:00 AM and then a partial closure with controlled traffic from 9:00 AM-17 12:00 PM:
  - Lake Street from Grant Street to Highway 29
  - Stevenson Street from Lincoln Avenue to Grant Street
  - Grant Street from Wapoo to Lake Street
- 21 They have also requested a full closure of Silverado Trail from Highway 29 to Crystal
- 22 Springs Road and California Highway Patrol has been contracted to provide traffic
- 23 control for this section of the race. There are approximately 1000 visitors expected and
- 24 approximately 100 volunteers at the event.

- 25 This closure will have a temporary impact on private resident access along these three
- 26 streets and the event planners will be responsible for neighborhood notification in
- 27 English and Spanish with Calistoga Police Department direction.
- 28 If the Council authorizes these uses of public streets, staff will process the specific
- 29 Special Event Permit and establish conditions of approval.

31 CONSISTENCY WITH CITY COUNCIL GOALS AND OBJECTIVES: Approving the 32 requested street closure would be consistent with Goal 1: Objective 2: Promote the 33 qualities of Calistoga that are attractive to residents and visitors.
