BACKGROUND: The Rotary Club of Calistoga (Rotary) has expressed interest in installing bocce ball courts at Logvy Park as a community service project. This would consist of 4 courts; picnic tables and most likely a shed to store equipment (see Attachment 2 & 3). The proposed location of the courts is at the southwest corner of Logvy Park next to the Napa River. This is the location that the Logvy Master Plan has indicated for use as future bocce ball courts (see Attachment 4). The proposal is for Rotary to install the courts and, upon completion, to hand the facility over to the City to maintain it.

City staff has reviewed the preliminary plans and has communicated to Rotary some of the issues that must be addressed with this project: ADA parking and access (500 foot path), trash can, drainage holding area, and the need to change the watering patterns in the field (the site presently has turf). The cost of these improvements has not been determined.

Staff is supportive of this project and would recommend that the Council approve the request in concept. Staff would work with Rotary to determine the extent of improvements needed as well as the budget. Should Rotary determine that they are able to raise the necessary funds, staff will bring the matter before the Council to request authorization to have the City Manager to enter into a design and construction agreement, similar to what was done for the Veteran's Memorial project.

Staff believes that after this project is completed it is likely that a bocce ball league will form in Calistoga, similar to St. Helena and Yountville. Usually these leagues want to reserve the courts at prime time for league play. If this occurs, City staff would require that they enter into a maintenance agreement with the City for them to take care of the facility.
