**ISSUE:** Consideration of a Resolution to enter into a professional services agreement with Fischer Computer Systems for Technology Services in an amount not to exceed

\$74,000.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt Resolution.

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**BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:** The City of Calistoga is organized according to the Council/Manager model with six departments with 49 full-time employees. The City currently has no full-time staff dedicated to information technology (IT), nor does it have someone trained or with an IT background. Information Technology leadership at the City is currently centered in the Finance Department for long-term planning, coordination between departments and contract oversight.

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16 17 The City's entire "hands-on" IT staffing is outsourced. This includes: client help desk support, desktop technician support, network administration, system administration, applications development, applications maintenance, data base administration, and specific project development, implementation and support.

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Fischer Computer Systems has been providing the City with 12 hours per week of IT for over fifteen years throughout the City. In September 2013 the City Council through

resolution 2013-084, added an additional 5 hours for the police department. Information technology is constantly expanding and the City of Calistoga is in need of keeping up with the times. An additional 2 hours per week is being recommended for additional staff and computer hardware to have Fischer Computer Systems assisting the City. Fischer Computer Systems specializes in computer and network related services and is cost conscious of the City's budget.

City staff in the Finance Department will continue to oversee and manage the contract as well as work as a liaison to consultant assisting in working with other departments in issues related to Information Technology needs.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** The City budget for FY 15-16 will allocate \$74,000 under account 15-4975-4402 for Information Technology outsourcing needs for 14 hours per week. Any additional hours outside the 14 hours per week will be preapproved and billed at an hourly rate of \$125.00 per hour. It is recommended that the agreement have a budget not to exceed \$74,000.

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**WHEREAS**, the City of Calistoga has six departments comprised of 49 full-time employees; and

**WHEREAS,** information technology is currently centered in the Finance Department for long-term planning, coordination between departments and contract oversight; and

**WHEREAS**, the City recognizes the need to have information technology outsourced for client help desk support, network and system administration, applications development, applications maintenance, data base administration and specific project development, implementation and support; and

**WHEREAS,** in June 2015 during budget workshops the Council adopted a strategic goal of improving the City's use of technology; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has successfully contracted with Fischer Computer Systems for information technology assistance for the last fifteen years and it is in the public interest to continue this relationship.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the City Council of the City of Calistoga hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a professional services agreement with Fischer Computer Systems in the amount not to exceed \$74,000 for information technology services as set forth in Exhibit A to this Resolution, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.
