into a Professional Services Agreement with the firm of Peckham & McKenney to conduct the Recruitment for a New City Manager in the amount not to exceed \$25,000 and to Approve a Budget Adjustment

in the Amount of \$30,000.

## APPROVAL FOR FORWARDING:

**ISSUE**: Consideration of a resolution authorizing the City Manager to enter into a professional services agreement with the firm of Peckham & McKenney to conduct the recruitment for a new City Manager in the amount not to exceed \$25,000 and to approve a budget adjustment in the amount of \$30,000.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt the Resolution.

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: The City Council established a sub-committee consisting of Mayor Canning and Councilmember Kraus at the August 18, 2015 regular meeting to seek the services of an executive recruitment consulting firm to assist in finding a new City Manager. This is to replace the existing City Manager who has announced his retirement at the end of December 2015.

The Mayor and Councilmember Kraus reviewed proposals from three executive search firms. All were determined to be qualified to undertake this task at comparable cost. Based upon their review they determined that Peckham & McKenney of Roseville, CA is best suited for Calistoga's needs. A reference check with recent clients has indicated that the firm has a good and proven track record. The following are the three firms that submitted proposals and their services budget:

Bob Murray & Associa

Bob Murray & Associates \$17,500 plus expenses estimated to be \$6,900

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the Recruitment for a New City Manager

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Peckham & McKenney \$18,500 plus expenses not-to-exceed \$6,500

Koff & Associates \$25,000 total cost

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The scope of services recommended by Peckham & McKenney is outlined in the attached proposal. The Council's sub-committee found the scope to be appropriate for our needs.

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**FISCAL IMPACT**: The adopted budget does not contain funds for this unanticipated expense. A budget adjustment will be necessary to allocate \$30,000 funds from the General Fund Undesignated Reserve to the Personnel Budget in the following manner: \$25,000 to 01-4172-4402 (the maximum cost of the consultant) and 01-4172-4405 to defray expenses associated with the interview of potential candidates for the position.
