2 Consideration of a one year time extension for approved use permit UP 2015-1, which

- 3 allowed the installation and operation of an antennae and an unmanned wireless
- 4 telecommunication facility at the Napa County Fairgrounds located at 1435 N. Oak

6 BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

- On February 11, 2015, the Planning Commission adopted Resolution 2015-3 allowing 7 the installation and operation of an antennae and an unmanned wireless 8 telecommunication facility at the Napa County Fairgrounds. The project entails Verizon 9 removing an existing 100' light standard in front of the central or main grandstand at the 10 track and replacing it with a new 100' light standard next to the track entrance 11 approximately 400' northwest, near the speedway guardrail of turn number 4. The 12 proposed facility will consist of placing 12 panel antennas oriented in 3 sectors (4 13 antennas per sector) at the top of the light standard with the appurtenant remote radio 14 heads and surge protection. The new Speedway light fixture will be installed below the 15 antennas to provide unimpeded access to the fixture by Speedway maintenance, staff 16 and contractors. This set up is operationally the best for both parties and avoids 17 interference with one another's access and servicing needs. 18
- Verizon Wireless's outdoor radio equipment cabinets and emergency power generator will be mounted on concrete pads within a fenced 20' x 26'-1" area between the west and main grandstands.
- Since this approval, the applicant has been in lease negotiations with the County. As such, more time is needed to finalize the lease terms, execute the lease and secure the necessary permits to construct the telecommunication facility. As a result, staff recommends that a one year time extension be granted in order to give the owner additional time to execute the lease and secure the proper permits. The Calistoga Municipal Code allows the granting of extensions for a period or periods of time not to
- exceed one year after the initial one-year approval period.
