**UpValley Family Centers Program Director Indira Lopez** stated California Rural Legal Assistance will be meeting with local citizens. Bay Area Legal Assistance will also be meeting with citizens on Monday, August 22. She asked for the City's support with helping these citizens. She mentioned the income is seasonal for most of the occupants of the Calistoga Family Apartments. She is concerned the occupant's annual income is being incorrectly calculated by taking the amount of one month and multiplying out for the year. Many months during the year have little or no income due to the seasonal nature of their occupation.

**Councilmember Lopez-Ortega** noted she was informed last week by a few members of the Calistoga Family Apartments of the issues with management.

**Councilmember Barnes** thanked those in the audience for letting the City Council know if this issue.

Bob Fiddaman, Napa, mentioned Napa Valley Fair Housing might be contacted to help with this issue. He also spoke as a representative of Napa County Fair Association and discussed the results of the Association's report asking to modify its governance by forming a Joint Powers Agreement (JPA) with the City of Calistoga and the County of Napa. He requested City staff look into such a JPA. Mayor Canning asked for Council consensus of creating a JPA. It was accepted by the Council to look into a JPA.
