**BACKGROUND**: State grant funds under the State of California Citizen's Option for Public Safety (COPS) program are in the process of being awarded to the City for fiscal year 2016/2017 for local law enforcement purposes.

The COPS program has been in existence for 20 years. The program was expanded in 2000 to provide each law enforcement agency with a minimum grant of \$100,000. The City of Calistoga has received \$100,000 COPS grant funds in prior years. This Fiscal Year 2016/2017 allocation will be our twenty-first and we expect the allocation to be \$100,000 once again.

The following summarizes permissible uses of COPS grant funds:

- Funding additional police officers;
- Utilizing overtime to increase police services;

- Hiring civilian personnel when the civilian employee performs duties which
   will free police officers to perform law enforcement duties; or
  - Purchasing equipment that will benefit "front line law enforcement."

The Calistoga Police Department can make a wise use of the COPS grant by expending these funds on personnel and equipment.

The COPS grant stipulates that the chief law enforcement administrator develop recommendations on expenditures of the funds for approval by the governing body.

Based on current budget assumptions, staff recommends using the 2016/2017 COPS grant in the following manner which may also be subject to revision if budget conditions change. Council may wish to set a new priority for use of this funding and may do so by resolution as long as the new priority meets criteria for permissible uses.

1. <u>Juvenile Diversion Program:</u> \$12,500 to be used to fund the Juvenile Diversion Program.

2. <u>Equipment/Additional Expenditures:</u> \$9,000 to fund miscellaneous supplies, expenses, etc.

3. <u>Community Service Officer/Personnel</u>: All remaining funds unspent on Items 1 and 2 above shall be applied towards the personnel costs of the community service officer position and a full-time police dispatcher position. The community service officer performs support services, code enforcement, vehicle abatement, and assists with property & evidence management.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** There is no matching fund requirement. This grant was anticipated in the FY 16/17 Calistoga Operating Budget, under Fund #41.
