APPLICANT City Initiated

Consideration of a Zoning Ordinance Text and Municipal Code amendment establishing provisions to authorize sidewalk dining establishments within the public rights-of-way in the Commercial Land Use Districts in the City of Calistoga. This proposed action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15061(b)(3)

of the CEQA Guidelines.

Staff recommends that the Planning Commission adopt Planning Commission Resolution PC 2008-44 recommending City Council approval of an Ordinance establishes provisions for authorizing sidewalk dining establishments within the public rightsof-way in the Commercial Land Use Districts, related definitions, and defines such use within rights-of-way as a public "routine encroachment".
