BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: Staff requested a proposal for Inspection Services related to the Grant Street Phase II Drainage Improvements Project from Consolidated CM.

These services are necessary to ensure a high quality product is built and the contract conforms to the project contract documents. Consolidated CM has previously provided similar services for the City's Mt Washington Water Storage Tank Project and the Calistoga Recycled Water Storage Pond Project.
